Pastor's Desk: Taking God at His Word

It seems like the authority of Scripture is constantly under attack. It is attacked by the usual 'suspects' of atheist thinkers and liberal theologians. But it is also attached by well-meaning Christians who claim to believe the authority of Scripture as the word of God, yet undermine that belief by certain attitudes, thoughts and behaviours.

Christians can find it hard to trust the Bible completely. We can wonder whether it really does contain everything we need for our complicated lives. And we often pursue additional means of revelation to tell us more than what the Bible says.

Can we take God at His word? Is His Word in the Scriptures enough, clear, final and necessary? This is what the Bible claims about itself;

It is enough: The Scriptures contain everything we need for knowledge of salvation and godly living. We don't need any new revelation from heaven.

It is clear: The saving message of Jesus Christ is plainly taught in the Scriptures and can be understood by all who have ears to hear it. We don't need a special person or a secret code to tell us what the Bible means.

It is final: The last word always goes to the word of God. We must never allow the teachings of science, of human experience, or of church councils to take precedence over Scripture.

It is necessary: General revelation is not enough to save us. We cannot know God savingly by means of personal experience and human reason. We need God's word to tell us how to live, who Christ is, and how to be saved.

Is this wat you believe? Is this something you have thought through and wrestled with?

I can also recommend a book I'm working through that was highly recommended to me (P.Ben) called 'Taking God at His Word' by Kevin DeYoung. "Ultimately we believe the Bible because we believe in the power and wisdom and goodness and truthfulness of the God whose authority and veracity cannot be separated from the Bible. We trust the Bible because it is God's Bible. And God being God, we have every reason to take Him at His word." (p.122)


