## **Worldly Leadership**

If you are a student who has been with us for four years then you would have astonishingly experienced Australia change Prime Minister twice—and neither time through a general election.

This merry-go-round of PM's has been... well, astonishing. In the past 10 years we have had 5 PM's. This figure is further mindboggling given that the previous 5 PM's led the country for over nearly 40 years together. Australia is not used to this much change.

Here are some thoughts on the events that have unfolded.

- 1. There is a growing disdain in our community for politics and politicians—and the switch of leadership on Friday only further cements this. Lots of my friends, even Christian friends, 'vocalised' concerns and contempt for particular parliamentary ministers. While some of this criticism is warranted, and in our country we have the right and privilege to fairly criticise our leaders, to me it appeared to verge on an unbiblical denunciation. Paul calls Christians to humbly submit to governing authorities in Romans 13. So even our criticism needs to be checked that we do not overstep the bounds that scripture encourages us towards.
- 2. If this merry-go-round of leadership in Australia has shown, leadership in the eyes of our world is so much about popularity and giftedness in terms of skill and communication. If we're not mindful this sort of thinking can creep into the church when we select leaders. It's worth being reminded that the leadership qualities and characteristics in Titus 2 and 1 Timothy 3 are predominantly about character—in particular godly characteristics that can only be tested over time.
- 3. It will be fascinating to see how the disunity that has been caused through this will be repaired (if at all). Unity in the world is found primarily through people working hard together for a common goal. Unity in the church is found first in the death of Jesus for us all, and the mission He gives to us.
- 4. The merry-go-round office of PM in Australia further highlights how much better Jesus is. There's no comparison actually. Jesus is the true King of His people, and His leadership will never fail, and His leadership is worth bowing down before and giving our lives for. So let us maintain our faith in Him, and not be tempted to trust in worldly governments for our worldly benefit.
