Coming Home (Isaiah 65:17-25) by Dane C. Ortlund

We've done it! As a church we've made it through the mammoth book of Isaiah. And while we haven't covered every detail, hopefully enough broad brushstrokes have been painted so that we can see the big idea of the book. As we come to the end, why not take some time over morning tea or lunch to share some of the big and memorable things you remember and were challenged with in this sermon series.

For now, here is a short devotional on Isaiah 65:17-25 by Dane C. Ortlund. It is copied from the ESV Men's Devotional Bible, which is on sale at the bookstore.

All of us know, deep down, the pain of alienation. We know we are foreigners, exiles, strangers in this fallen world. When we return to our home nation after traveling abroad, we taste the joy of coming home; but even then, we know we are not experiencing fully what the soul longs for. Even in our own living room we can feel estranged.

The message of the Bible is that we were, at one time, truly home. In Eden we had not yet been estranged. But with the fall into sin, we became alienated—not only from Eden but also from God, from one another, and even from ourselves. The story of redemption is God's work throughout history to restore us to him, to one another, and to ourselves. In Isaiah 65 we are given a glimpse into what this final restoration in a "new heaven and a new earth" (v.17) will look like. In short, it means Eden will be regained—this time invincibly. We will be home. No more death, no more futility in our work, no more building a home only to leave it to another (65:21-22).

In C. S. Lewis's The Last Battle, the final book in the Chronicles of Narnia, Jewel the unicorn expresses everyone's thoughts as Aslan's people enter the restored Narnia: "I have come home at last! This is my real country! I belong here. This is the land I have been looking for all my life, though I never knew it till now." That is exactly what we will feel one day as the sun sets on this hellish world and the new world dawns. The horrors of the old age will die away. We will pass through the wardrobe into Narnia. We will be home at last. "I will bring them home," God says (Zech 10:10). We will weep with relief. We will see him face to face (Rev. 22:4).

How can this be? Here's how: God in Christ refused the glory he rightly deserved to enter the hell and mud of our world to grab us and drag us, kicking and screaming if need be, into the new order, the new world of shalom and flourishing and sun and wine and calmness and nonfrivolous laughs. All of sheer grace. All to be simply received. Available to anyone who refuses to pay for it.
