5 reasons why Scripture is our ultimate authority

I love brie. It's a great soft cheese. It's also a great way to work out the biggest authority in someone's life. Let me explain.

In matters of authority BRIE stands for Bible, Reason, Institutions (ie Traditions), and Experience. When it comes to matters of faith and spirituality what do you fall upon as your primary source of authority?

While using our reasoning, relying on our experiences, or falling upon our institutions or traditions is not necessarily wrong, when it comes to what we believe and how we respond to our faith, the Bible should have the highest authority.

Here are a few reasons why the Bible needs to be the priority in matters of faith and spirituality:

- Jesus prioritised the Word. When he fended off Satan in the wilderness (Matt 4:1-11), corrected misapplication of the Sabbath (Matt 12:1-5) and misapplication of rules of cleanliness (Mark 7:1-13), or pointed to what framed the purpose of His ministry (Luke 18:31, 22:37), Jesus put God's Word front and centre.
- 2. The Apostles prioritised the Word. In one example from the book of Acts, when the Apostles heard of the conversion of the Gentiles and the Holy Spirit descending upon them, they turned to Scripture to inform their understanding of these events (Acts 15:1-18). Scripture was used to filter their experience.
- 3. Paul used Scripture to reason for the gospel. In the towering letter of Romans he reasons clearly that our perfect standing before God (righteousness) is received by faith alone. And in order to argue his point he refers to Abraham's story in Genesis (cf Rom 4:1-12) and quotes David from Psalm 32. Paul doesn't use reasoning alone, but his reasoning is rooted in a shaped by Scripture.
- 4. Paul would later declare that because 'All scripture is God-breathed' it made it perfect and sufficient for all our spiritual needs (cf 2 Time 3:14-16).
- 5. The church, during the Protestant Reformation, returned to prioritising Scripture as the ultimate authority. It is a distinctive hallmark of reformed theology that the Bible rises above other forms of authority (reason, institutions/traditions, and experience) and is constantly reforming our faith (in regards tour knowledge and living).

There are five reasons why Scripture should be our chief authority in matters of faith. What would you say is your chief authority in life?
