# The way we teach and why.

When you came to church this morning how much did you come with the expectation that God would speak to you? I'm guessing we're all on some spectrum between, 'Barely able to stay awake to hear anyone speak to us' to 'Came with the highest expectation to hear from God.'

As important as that question is—and where we lie on that spectrum—another question, perhaps as important, is how do we expect God to speak to us?

It is the conviction of the elders and leaders of SLE Church that God speaks to us today primarily through the Scriptures. This informs the way we preach and teach from the Bible, and also informs one of the core values of our church: the valuing of gospel-centred expository preaching of God's Word.

Expository preaching is a slightly fancy way of talking about preaching where the main passage of the sermon reflects the main message of the passage. Gospel-centred is another way of saying that every message will point to Jesus—in the Old Testament we will hear how God is preparing us for the coming of Jesus, and in the New Testament we will hear how God explains the person and work of Jesus.

Through this year we'll be looking at the letter of 1 John, a doctrinal series on 'Union with Christ', the Old Testament book Leviticus, and we'll begin our year with the Gospel of Mark.

So if you're new with us today I hope you'll notice that the way the Bible is taught might be different. Different in its tone and emphasis. Different in its point and purpose. We hope, and pray, you'll walk away with a clearer understanding of Mark's gospel, and most of all: a clearer understanding of the Jesus we trust and believe to be our Lord and source of greatest joy, and a clear understanding of what we must do with this news.

After the sermon we usually spend some time reflecting on what we have heard. It is our practice to encourage people to share with the person next to you what you've learned and been challenged with. There are usually some guided reflection questions displayed on the screens. We spend this time to encourage God's Word to sink deep within us, and to share how God has spoken to us through His Word that morning. May we be blessed as we hear God speaking to us today!
