### Why We're Not Preaching Mark 16:9-20

No, we're not deleting sections of your Bible—and nor are recent Bible translations trying to take verses out of Scripture. But there are very good and legitimate reasons that Mark 16:9-20 was not originally written by Mark, nor intended.

The first reason is the documentary evidence. When the Bible was first translated into English the translators had only a small handful of Greek manuscripts to work from. They did great work, and we should be truly thankful for their translation and how it massively impacted our own translations (around 2/3rds of the New Testament in the ESV is the same as William Tyndale's original translation!". But since the 1500's we've made many (ie. Thousands) more discoveries of New Testament documents, and through painstaking research scholars have been able to map out a number of manuscript family trees. What they discovered was that the Greek manuscripts used by the first English translators came from a much later period of copying, and many of these manuscripts included more passages and verses than what are widely considered earlier documents. This is why you'll notice in the ESV that there is a note to say that 'some of the earlier manuscripts do not contain Mark 16:9-20'. This is a compelling reason to raise question marks about the validity of these verses.

A second reason why these verses are unlikely to be written by Mark is the language of 16:9-20—specifically the vocabulary, phrases, and grammar. There is a noticeable change in the writing style and 'voice' from verse 9 onwards which leads many to believe that this was a much later addition to the gospel. It is theorised that a later scribe was confused by the sudden ending to the gospel (which we believe to be intentional—the sermon today will explain why!) and inserted his own collection of stories and sayings, influenced by the rest of the New Testament, to give a more rounded conclusion to this gospel.

This might sound unsettling, but fear not! Of the passages often in question (including John 7:53-8:11), and a few other verses or words) no major doctrines hang on them, and nothing is lost in the gospels if those passages were removed. There is generally very few arguments about the vast majority of Scripture's accuracy and reliability. So keep reading the Word you have and trust that it truly is God's intended word for you!
