

Appointed Feasts	Re-appointed in Christ
Passover	Good Friday/Lord's Supper
Feast of Unleavened Bread	Easter/Lord's Supper
Feast of Firstfruits	(Resurrection)
Feast of Weeks	Pentecost (coming of the Spirit)
Feast of Trumpets (Day of solemn rest)	(Gospel rest)
Day of Atonement	(Gospel salvation)
Feast of Booths	(Gospel salvation)
