Finishing the Story Well

Two of my favourite film franchises are essentially long-running series. Star Wars and its 9 movies focused on the Skywalker family and the Marvel Cinematic Universe (MCU), 23 films focused on a group of superheroes defending the world from the threat of the mega-threat Thanos. And this year we've seen two movies which sought to bring those long-running stories to a close: Avengers Endgame and Star Wars: The Rise of Skywalker.

On Thursday evening I was invited to see the final Star Wars movie. I really enjoyed it, but I noticed a few glaring issues which further reviews have raised and clarified. Without spoiling any details, let's just say that I didn't think that the movie ended in the most satisfying way, try as it might. On the other hand, Avengers Endgame left me profoundly satisfied that they had brought their movie franchise to a gratifying conclusion. So, what happened?

A lot of the blame can fall squarely on Star Wars episode 8: The Last Jedi with its wasted opportunities and confusing storyline, and what is now become clear that the main writers and producers of the final three Star Wars movies had little or no unifying ideas/story when they began production of them. So, while the final movie (Episode 9: The Rise of Skywalker) was entertaining (and, as a fan, enjoyable) I still couldn't help but feel a sense of lack.

This observation led me to thank God for the Bible. Here's why.

Imagine for a moment that the Bible only consisted of the book of Romans. It would be utterly confusing. Some nice words about loving each other in Rom 14 but everything else would make little sense. What if you had just the New Testament letters and some of the early books like Genesis and Exodus? Would that be sufficient? No. Imagine for a moment that the Gospels burst onto the scene of the Bible and basically say that the answers to all the questions and expectations in Old Testament don't really matter. Would that make sense? No.

The Bible works wondrously together as a consistent whole. Every book of the Bible adds to and builds God's progressive revelation that is fully and finally revealed. The idea of a unified cinematic universe is generally quite new. But in the Bible we already have that—and it is wonderfully real. The Bible contains a climax and future ending which is way more satisfying than what the best film franchise could produce.

This year I enjoyed the finish to the MCU and found the Star Wars finish ok. Praise God that His Word finishes our story in an infinitely better way.
