The Hope for Introverts (and Extroverts)

Over the past few months I've had many conversations with people thinking about how they can grow their relationships with the people around them in church. The conversations have taken a fairly usual path after asking why they find it hard to talk to people: "Oh, I find it very hard... because I'm an introvert."

But is this all there is to it?

It seems to me that introversion is often pointed to in order to excuse us from building relationships with others. Now I don't want to say that introverts alone have a weakness. For those who don't know there is an equal temptation for extroverts which also hinders relationship building: our tendency to enjoy the energy people give us but to never go deeper than shallow conversations.

Yet even these weaknesses in our personalities are part of the 'all things' that are from Him and to Him (Romans 11:36) in subjection under his feet (cf 1 Corinthians 15:27). So, whether you're an ISTJ or an ENFP, a 'Challenger' or a 'Helper' (Enneagram types), your personality has been crafted by God for you and falls under the lordship of Jesus. Yes, even our personality—shy or outgoing, thinker or feeler—is to be submitted to Jesus and used for His glory.

So where to from here?

First, be encouraged—how you feel and who you are is a wonderful reflection of who God has created you to be.

Next, be encouraged, again—the worst of how you feel about yourself is not the final word, and you are not enslaved to any personality weakness you see in yourself. Prayerfully seek to submit our weaknesses to God's shaping. By the empowerment of the Spirit we can change.

Don't be discouraged if you don't see change quickly enough. Keep asking God for opportunities—and the willingness to take up those opportunities—to further your relationships at church in order to love and build each other up.

Remember, the goal of our gathering is to build each other up towards maturity in Christ (cf Ephesians 4:13) and we do this by speaking God's Word to each other (cf Ephesiains 4:15). Words of encouragement, sharing, prayer, and testimony as we share with each other about how God is working in our lives through His Word.

It's this goal—mutual encouragement and growth—that makes the effort in submitting our personalities to God worth it!
