Why (some of) you should buy more books

So the past Ignite Training Conference week was filled with great laughs, great conversations, and hard work as those in attendance wrestled to understand God's word, teach it clearly, and apply it faithfully to our own lives. Gary Millar, Principal of Queensland Theological College took us through the voice of the Prophets and while it was hard work many of us left floored and in awe of their message: calling God's people back to the beautiful life (or Torah keeping!) made possible through the beautiful saviour to come.

And as with the previous years, my job was strand leading and organising the bookstall. Also, as with previous years, many a great conversation was had over the books as many recommendations and suggestions were made.

And as with previous years one common excuse came up for not buying any books: "I have a big pile of unread books, so I should read them first before buying new books."

That's a common thought, but there's one crucial thing I'd like to ask: says who? Sure, if we have a pile of books to read then it'll be a good idea to get into the habit of reading (15 minutes a day and you'll finish 20 books a year!). But buying books, and building your own library, isn't just an activity that benefits you. Sure, it benefits you primarily—but it can be of great benefit for others as well. If you have the means you should consider building a theological library as a ministry to others. Maybe a few books at a time, maybe one at a time—but stocking up on books that have been recommended can be of great benefit for others in our lives.

I'm also a firm believer that if you have started and stopped a few books then that's not a bad thing. If a book isn't able to draw you in and you've paused and restarted a few times then that's not your fault, necessarily. Find good books that you'll finish.

Finally, as a small counter point to the above it is a good thing to not impulse buy. Take your time to read through the book, read the recommendations, and figure out if this is something you would find useful.

And if you're ever at a conference consider purchasing from that bookstall rather than online. This year the Wandering Bookseller was able to partner with us. Based in Katoomba business has been a particularly hard over a summer where bushfires threatened the area. Purchasing from them helped not only their business but also their ministry to get good books into the hands of good people.

As always, your pastors and elders are available to give good book recommendations.
