Gospel Generosity

Flowing out of Paul's confidence in the Corinthians (2 Cor 7), he calls on them to see through a financial commitment they had made to the church in Jerusalem, which they had neglected. In these 2 chapters, Paul calls on those who have received the overflowing grace of God in the gospel to express that in the grace of generous giving. Generous giving is not only evidence for gospel grace and true love in the giver, but also results in the needs of others being met and God being glorified.

PRAISE GOD THAT HIS GOSPEL WORKS
