

PRAISE GOD FOR THE DEEP CHALLENGES WE HAVE HEARD AND READ IN THE GOSPEL OF LUKE SO FAR. Praise God that these challenges have not gone unnoticed and unheeded. Praise God that our pastors and teachers do not shy away from difficult passages that confront and challenge our lives.

PRAY THAT WE WOULD RECEIVE THESE CHALLENGES WITH SOFT AND OPEN HEARTS. Pray that we would count the cost of following Jesus to be worth it. Pray for soft hearts as we consider the ways in which pride has elevated ourselves over others. Pray for soft hearts as we reconsider our priorities—asking that God would help us discern where our desire for comfort or other pressing areas of life has crowded out our Kingdom responsibilities. Ask that God would restore among us a renewed desire to serve him for all the days of our lives, to not be double-minded in our service to him, and to not rest on past achievements or service.

PRAY FOR THE UPCOMING QUEENSLAND GOVERNMENT— whatever the outcome of yesterday's election. Pray that our Government would govern well, and that they would serve the needs of those in our community: born and yet to be born. Pray for ongoing wisdom in regards to our state borders and their closures.

PRAY FOR THE ONGOING GLOBAL PANDEMIC. Pray that God would continue to bring to an end the effects of this virus. Pray for Europe in the grip of a large second wave. Pray for us to continue to be diligent in loving and caring for others.
