

2021 CHURCH @ HOME GROUPS

In 2021, Church @ Home groups will run closely with the school term. 5 weeks each round with 2 weeks break during school holidays. During the 2 weeks break, there will not be planned home group meetings. Therefore, hosts are not expected to host during breaks. However, where possible, we encourage everyone to keep churching together physically even during the break. This could mean meeting with your old homegroup or with others.

As part of the readjustment of schedule, there will no longer be a holiday 2 round after the current round finishes this Sunday (3 Jan). In its place is a 2 weeks break (10 & 17 Jan).
