Conquer Self-Sufficiency

Jesus warns that self-sufficiency is a gravely serious problem, and calls Christians to renew our zeal for Jesus and desire for what Jesus gives. We are to repent of worldliness and self-sufficiency that prevents this zeal for Jesus.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD FOR THE WONDERFUL PROMISES OF JESUS FOR THOSE WHO CONQUER. Praise God that these promises are freely and abundantly given by the grace of Jesus and guaranteed by His death and resurrection. Pray that we would conquer to the end to receive these rich promises along with the promise keeper Himself.

PRAY FOR SOFT HEARTS TO HEAR THE FINAL ADDRESS TO LAODICEA— that we would examine our hearts, and test whether we have become 'lukewarm' towards Jesus. Pray that we would repent of our self-sufficient ways, of living as though Jesus is not necessary, and renew our zeal to serve Him and His kingdom.

PRAY FOR THE MANY TOWNS AND CITIES AFFECTED BY THE RECENT RAINS AND FLOODS. Pray for relief efforts to be generous and quick. Pray for the many people who will be cleaning up and recovering over the next months and years from their losses. Pray that God would use these floods to remind them of God's promises to them in the gospel: that rising waters were a sign of judgement in the past, but Christ has come to take that judgement away should they trust and follow Him.
