The Six Seals

The Lamb opens the seals showing his sovereignty in judgement on the earth and in the persecution of believers, as final judgement awaits. This brings understanding, comfort and perseverance to believers as they await final vindication. This also brings warning to unbelievers to turn to Jesus as they taste the foretaste of final judgement.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD, AGAIN, FOR THE BOOK OF JOB – a massive book, exploring wisdom and faith in the middle of suffering. Pray that the lessons we've learned may last us a lifetime and sustain our faith in the years ahead – especially during the dark seasons of suffering and trial we all go through. Pray that we would cling onto the goodness of God and trust in his sovereign control and wisdom in all things.

PRAISE GOD THAT GOD AND JESUS ARE ON THE THRONE. Praise God that Jesus is the One with authority to open the scrolls – and so enact God's plans and purposes in this world. Praise God that he is worthy of all worship and praise – and pray that we would joyfully join the worship and praise of Jesus! Pray that we would not outlive our desire or joy in following Him.

PRAY FOR THE UPCOMING CHURCH @ HOME GROUPS NEW ROUND. Pray that God would sustain us through the weariness of the year so far, and that we would be enthused again to meet with God's people to mutually encourage each other as we sit under God's Word together. Pray for a high registration and attendance rate – that the numbers would reflect a growing desire within each of us to gather as God's people.

PRAISE GOD FOR THE MANY GOOD THINGS THAT ARE HAPPENING IN OUR CHURCH CALENDAR AT THE MOMENT. The past Grunt session, the upcoming Bloom session, Singleness workshop, membership classes, Christianity Explained classes, on top of our weekly fellowship and bible study gatherings. Pray that God would use the times to grow our fellowship and relationships, be inclusive of newcomers and outsiders, and continue to edify and encourage each other to pursue holiness together.
