Judgement Against Jerusalem

The LORD's judgement against Jerusalem is totally just and deeply tragic, yet there is still hope for those in exile. The remnant in exile is to be clear on the reasons and the tragedy of the LORD's judgement, so that they would commit themselves to being faithful to the LORD, rejecting idolatry, longing for the promise of a new heart, and a restored relationship with God.

For believers today, we are to not think any less of God's judgement, but rejoice in the new heart we have been given by Christ and so commit ourselves to utter faithfulness and obedience.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD THAT HE IS JUST.

He will not let sin go unpunished. Praise God that the evils and the wickedness of this world will not be forgotten by Him and is not ignored. Praise God that He is not powerless or impotent to prevent and condemn sin.

PRAISE GOD THAT THE WRATH AND

justice we deserve is mercifully and graciously propitiated by His Son, Jesus Christ. Pray that this good news would be received with an even deeper and greater joy as we continue to consider the nature and extent of God's judgement upon sin. Pray that our hearts and minds would be moved into a deeper worship of God for how much mercy has been shown to us. Pray that we would speak of this mercy in richer and more urgent ways to our non-Christian friends and family—asking that God would use our words to convict of sin and the need for faith and repentance.

PRAISE GOD THAT THE RECENT

cluster of infections in Brisbane has been contained. Pray that this would allow us to return to relative 'normalcy' in our lives—and especially that our church might be able to regather in number again.

PRAY FOR THE ONGOING OUTBREAK

in NSW and Victoria. Pray that the governing officials would wisely handle the situation, and for those who live in these areas to also act wisely for the benefit of their community and neighbours. Ask for God to help bring this outbreak under control and to end it swiftly. Pray for the many churches who have been affected by this lockdown—that their ministries would continue to be faithful as they seek to disciple their members and win the lost.

PRAY FOR GOD'S KINGDOM WORK

that continues in the background of all that is happening in our world. Praise God that the gospel is never able to be locked down! Pray that we would be reminded of the many ways God continues to be at work drawing people into His Kingdom, even when we are so preoccupied with life. Pray that this reminder would fuel our own part to play in the growth of His Kingdom.
