CONTINUE TO PRAY FOR THE CHURCH PLANT PLANNING.

Pray for wisdom on how we should best proceed, and how to best partner with other like-minded churches seeking to reach Brisbane with the gospel. Pray for our search for a third pastor, that God would help us find the right man who will be ready to lead and teach and fit in well with our present staff and leadership teams. Pray that our planning and timing would be God's plan and time—and pray that we would be humble in 'waiting' while we may be anxious to 'go'.
