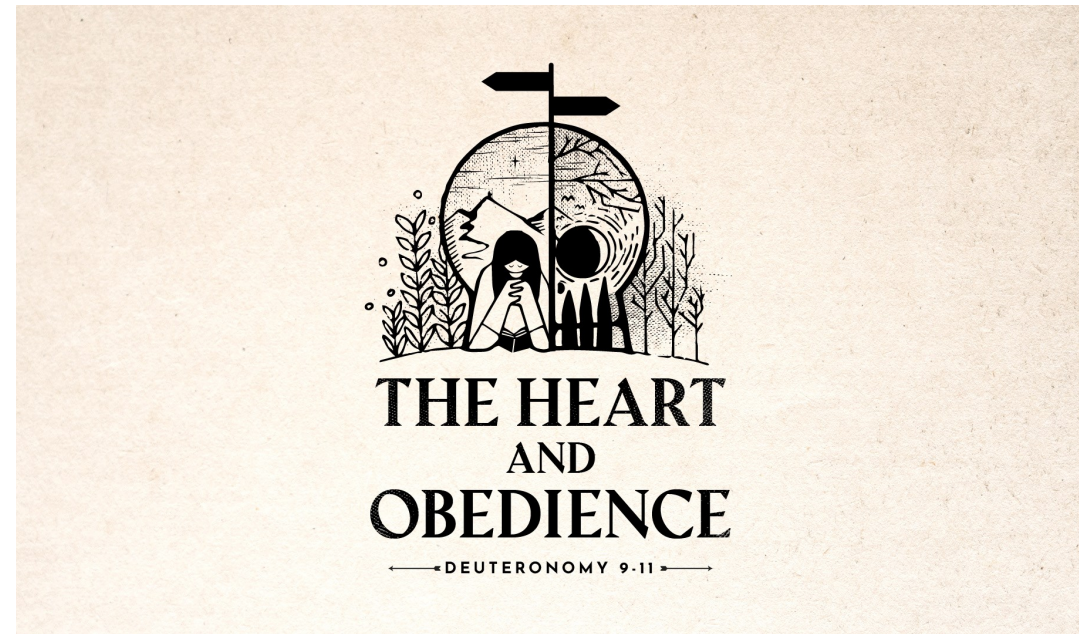

The Heart of the Matter

God's relentless grace and faithfulness shapes our hearts to be totally set apart in devotion and obedience to him.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD THAT HE HAS GRACIOUSLY SAVED HIS PEOPLE out of slavery to sin and given them a new identity in His Son. Praise God that this new identity brings reconciled relationship with Him and renewed purpose for life. Pray that this new identity will be the basis for our joyful obedience to Jesus and his commands. Pray especially that in our times of struggling to obey that we would spend quality time meditating in order for our hearts to 'remember' the great things God has done. Pray that this remembrance would greatly impact and renew our desire to live obediently.

PRAY THAT GOD WOULD BE AT WORK IN US to remember that our hearts are truly renewed by trusting Jesus. Pray that our renewed hearts will encourage us and bolster us in our desire to live faithfully before him. Pray that we would encourage each other towards this as well – that in our weakness and struggles we can ever lean on His grace and mercy, and to then repent.

PRAISE GOD FOR THE MANY SURPRISING THINGS WE HAVE LEARNED AND HEARD so far in the book of Deuteronomy. Praise God for how the gospel has been so clear even in the Old Testament. Pray that we would continue to hunger to hear from God as his word is preached and read in the coming weeks.

PRAY FOR THE UPCOMING BLOOM EVENT FOR THE WOMEN OF SLE CHURCH. Pray that as the women hear about friendship that they would be greatly encouraged to go deeper and more personally with each other – that honesty and transparency in their relationships will lead to encouragement and growth as followers of Christ. Pray for the organisation of the day to run smoothly, and for Sonja to speak clearly and encouragingly.

PRAY FOR THE MANY ILLNESS THAT ARE STILL IMPACTING MANY PEOPLE AT CHURCH. Pray for God's mercy in helping them to recover quickly. Pray that our church would find ways to love and serve those who are ill, that we might show the love of Christ to each other.
