Covenantal Renewal and Repentance

God mercifully renews our stubborn hearts so that we can embrace the gospel of the risen Lord Jesus and choose life.

Prayer Points

PRAISE GOD THAT WE NO LONGER LIVE UNDER THE CURSES OF THE OLD COVENANT – but by faith in Jesus alone that curse has been lifted! Praise God that by his grace we are freed from putting ourselves under the burden of the Law and its curses. Pray that our meditation upon the curses of the Old Covenant would help us grasp the magnitude, depth, and beauty of the Cross more and more. Pray that we would also not neglect the privilege to now live under the Law of Christ, and seek to grow in our obedience to Jesus and his word.

PRAISE GOD THAT WHEN MOSES SPEAKS OF THE WORD BEING ‘NOT TOO HARD NOR TOO FAR’ that these are profoundly true in the gospel. Praise God that in the Gospel our sins are forgiven and we are empowered by the Spirit to live in obedience to his word. Praise God that the nearness of God’s commands is true – for the Spirit dwells within. Pray that we would earnestly rely on God’s Spirit to empower us in our obedience and help us to say no to sin.

PRAY FOR TIMES OF REST IN THE WEEKS AND MONTHS AHEAD. With many of us feeling tired and weary, pray that God would grant times of restoration – free from work and gracious times of reprieve from the stresses of life. Pray that we would embrace sabbath rests well – that we would not be reliant upon holidays for rest, but that our weekly rhythms would include days devoted to physical stopping and spiritual renewal. Ask for wisdom in how to best do that in our various stages of life.

PRAY FOR OUR WORLD AS IT GRAPPLES WITH MANY AND VARIED ISSUES that continue to polarise. Pray for God’s common grace to bring community morals and ethics back to the place he originally designed for human flourishing. Pray for Christians to be wise in how they engage with our world’s issues – asking that our witness would grow in Gospel-centredness and that our lives would truly reflect the teachings and life of Jesus. Pray that this witness and our gospel preaching would be the great light to our darkened world.
