Refuge in the Risen King

Find refuge in Jesus because he is our risen forever king.

Prayer Points

Praise God for sending his Son Jesus into the world to be born at the right time to save all sorts of people. Pray that we would not be troubled at the arrival of Jesus, or pretend that he is our king, but that we would rejoice that Jesus is the king who saves us, and respond by falling down and worshipping him.

Pray that when we find ourselves in the midst of grief and tiredness that we would find refuge in Jesus and the hope of his resurrection. Pray that as we look forward to next year, what it would look like to entrust our lives to Jesus our king.

Pray for all those whom Kong has shared the gospel with, that they might come to know Jesus as their Lord and Saviour and trust in the true and certain hope of the resurrection.
