## **The Appointment of Pastors, Elders and Deacons**

### **Elders**

#### **Role**

An Elder is a spiritual leader of the Church and must shepherd the Church in accordance with Scripture and the Objects and Statement of Faith and Practices of the Church.

He is charged with the duties of caring for the spiritual well-being of members and other attendees of the Church, teaching and exhortation, and the visitation of members and attendees of the Church (1 Peter 5:1-3; Titus 1:6-9)

An Elder may be called upon to minister to the whole Church at times.

#### **Eligibility**

A male member of the Church who

- is over the age of twenty-five years, and
- has been a Member of the Church for at least two years, and
- is fit to be a spiritual leader and possesses the attributes specified in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, and
- upholds the Objects and Statement of Faith and Practices of the Church

may be considered for formal recognition as an Elder of the Church.

### **Nominees for Elder**

#### **Jacky Suen**

Jacky has been with SLE Church since 2014 and has been with CCCB since 1996. He began serving at CCCB in 1998 as a Kids Church Teacher (aka Sunday School back then). Since then, he has served across CPC (Coopers Plains Chinese Church) and CPE (Coopers Plains English Church) in various ministries, such as serving in Sunday Services (in Chairing, Translation and Technical Support); serving as the Chair of Youth Fellowship at CPC and started the Teens Group at CPE. He was also a Deacon of the CCCB Church Council for over 10 years and appointed as the Secretary for 6 of those years. He was involved in the CPE Church building committee as the congregation moved to their current building, as well as chaired a number of church camps and led several evangelistic events.
