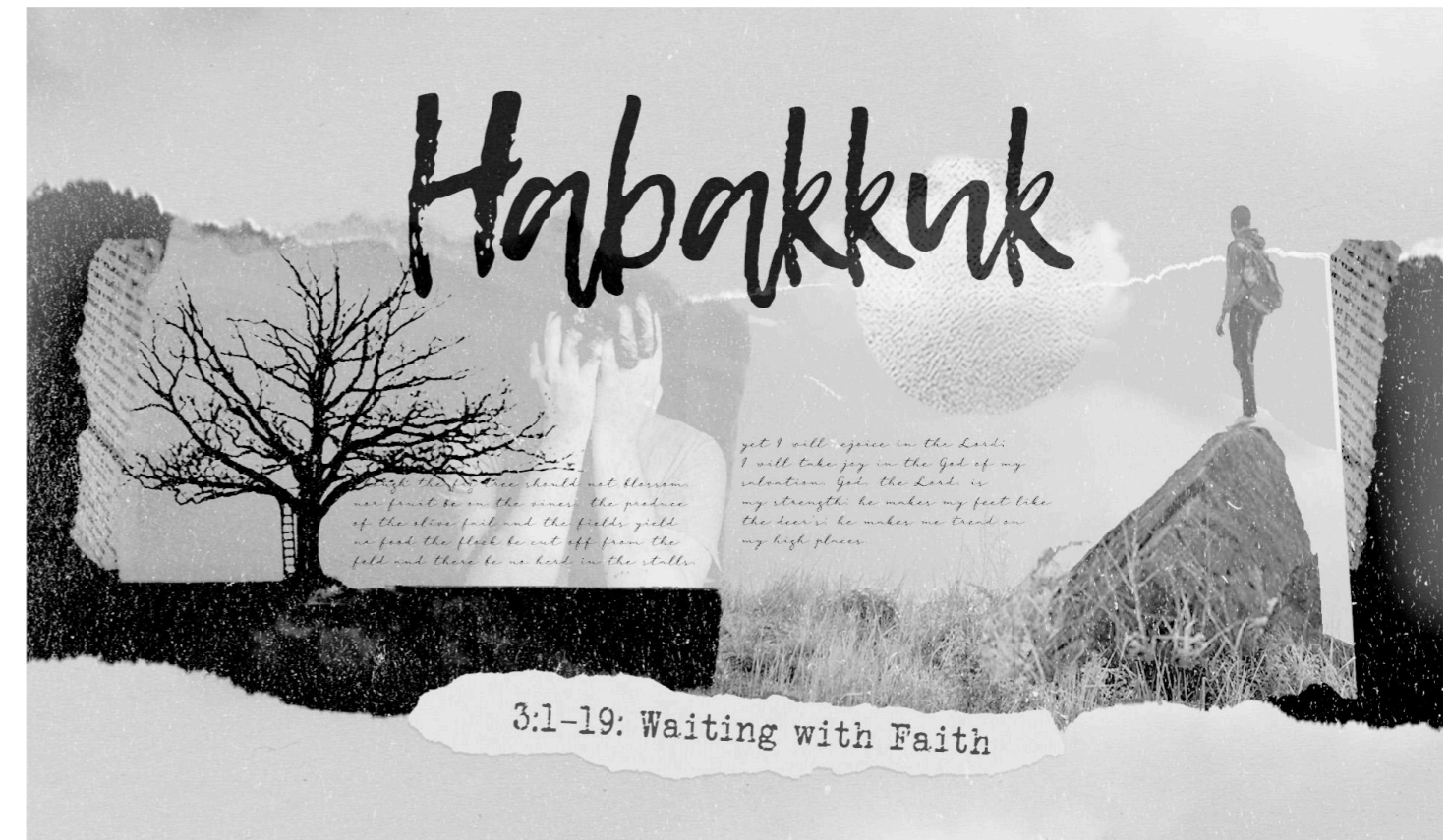

Waiting With Faith

God's past acts of justice and mercy assures those who await his promised salvation.

Prayer Points

Praise God for the gift of faith! Praise God that he overcomes the deadness of our sin to give us new life, and that we can turn to trust in him because of this. Praise God that this faith, alone, is what brings us into right standing before him. Pray that genuine faith roots itself so deeply in our lives that it pushes out and kills pride. Pray that humility marks us as faith works its way through our lives. Pray for ongoing humble trust in God as we seek to follow him.

Pray for the growing anti-semitism in our community. Pray for God's grace to pour out in a special way: to guard and protect the Jewish community from attacks, and to work in the hearts of those who hate. Pray especially for God to draw everyone to Christ, who taught us to love our enemies, and not hate them, and demonstrated that by dying for his enemies to give them life.

Thank God for the many students visiting and returning to SLE. Pray that as they come and settle in, connections will be made to a church community. Pray that they will find a church family and home among us at SLE and grow in maturity as disciples as they know and love him and the church.

Pray for each other as our Grow Groups begin – especially that as many of us dive into Romans that it will be a stretching and deepening time – to deepen not just our knowledge of God's word, but also that our hearts and lives would respond accordingly. Pray also for Women's Group who have started 2 Corinthians, that in this other big letter from Paul they would be encouraged to press on in ministry.

Pray for 'Taste and See'. Thank God for this unique evangelistic opportunity, which presents the gospel clearly and in such a warm and engaging way. Praise God that there are already 8 friends and 5 children who have signed up to come! Praise God for the volunteers who have helped so far, and for the volunteers who will be helping in future weeks. Pray for Ps Richard as he prepares the talks and engages with the Q&A – for his gospel presentations to be clear and winsome. Pray for the SLEers in attendance – that their conversations would be loving, gentle, and respectful. Pray for the youth to be welcoming to outsiders.

Give thanks for Laurie and May Glen's wedding yesterday! Thank God for how he has worked in their lives individually, bringing them to know Him as Saviour, and then to know each other. Pray that their marriage would be a wonderful picture of the gospel.
