Discussion Questions:

1. Hidden with Christ

Read Col 3:1-4, 12-15. We receive many benefits when we are in Christ. What are you thankful for?

Write a short reflection.

2. Let the Word dwell richly

What might it look like for the Word to dwell in you richly day by day? What practices could you adopt in your current routine?

• Share your ideas with the wider group in order to help us all think creatively how we can be reminding ourselves of our identity in Christ.

3. Relationships in Christ

Colossians 3 has comforted us and challenged us to live out our union with Christ. The exhortations have been rich and varied. We've seen that Christ is all in all, that we are to put off sin, and to live lives characterised by love, gentleness, patience, and forgiveness. The final section applies this identity to our relationships - speaking directly to wives, children, workers, and masters. In this section we'll consider our current relationships.
