The Appointment of Pastors, Elders and Deacons

Elders

Role

An Elder is a spiritual leader of the Church and must shepherd the Church in accordance with Scripture and the Objects and Statement of Faith and Practices of the Church.

He is charged with the duties of caring for the spiritual well-being of members and other attendees of the Church, teaching and exhortation, and the visitation of members and attendees of the Church (1 Peter 5:1-3; Titus 1:6-9)

An Elder may be called upon to minister to the whole Church at times.

Eligibility

A male member of the Church who

- is over the age of twenty-five years, and
- has been a Member of the Church for at least two years, and
- is fit to be a spiritual leader and possesses the attributes specified in 1 Timothy 3:1-7, and
- upholds the Objects and Statement of Faith and Practices of the Church

may be considered for formal recognition as an Elder of the Church.

Deacons

Role

A Deacon shall serve the Church in such administrative duties as decided by the Church Council.

Deacons shall keep the members of the Church adequately informed of the business of the Church Council.

Eligibility

A male or female member of the Church who

- is over the age of eighteen years, and
- has been a Member of the Church for at least one year, and
- has generally the qualifications for office as specified in 1 Timothy 3:8-13, and
- upholds the Objects and Statement of Faith and Practices of the Church

may be nominated for the position of Deacon of the Church.

Nominees for Elder

Daniel MW Tan

Dan has been with CCCB since 1983 and has served as an Elder in the Church since 2010. He is married to Lin and they have two adult children, Lucas and Mark. Dan oversees the SOS East Grow Group (young families).

Nominees for Deacon

Eilen Wong

Eilen joined the CCCB English Congregation in 2007. She went to the 5:17 church plant from 2008 to 2013 and has been back with SLE church since 2014.

She is married to Winston and has one son Evan.

Eilen is an active member of the SOS East Grow Group. She serves in the music team and in the Bloom women's ministry. She is the Safe Ministry Coordinator in SLE and has been a Deacon on the Church Council since 2024.

Esmond Leong

Esmond has been with SLE church since 2019. He is married to Vanessa.

Esmond serves as an international YF leader, a Grow Group area leader, and as part of the church music team. He has been a Deacon on the SLE Church Council since 2024.

Stanley Huang

Stanley first attended SLE Church in mid-2022. However, after graduation, Stanley returned to Singapore in 2014 and returned to SLE Church in early 2018.

He is married to Liesl.

Stanley serves as an International Youth Fellowship (IYF) Grow leader and also is the team leader of the PA ministry. He has been a Deacon on the SLE Church Council since 2024.

Winnie Wong

Winnie joined CCCB English Congregation in 1993 and has served as a Deacon of SLE Church since 2012, and served in many areas of church ministry over the years.

She is married to Randy Chan. Together they have two daughters, Isabelle and Christine.
